## **FAMILY DAY ACT**

### **Chapter F-4**

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

#### **Family Day**

- 1** In recognition of the importance of the family, the 3rd Monday in February in each year shall be observed as a public holiday and known as “Alberta Family Day”.
