**Public Health Act**

**QUALIFICATIONS OF EXECUTIVE OFFICERS REGULATION**

**Definition**

**1** In this Regulation, “Board of Certification” means the Board of Certification of the Canadian Institute of Public Health Inspectors.

**Qualifications of executive officers**

**2(1)** A regional health authority shall not appoint a person as an executive officer unless the person holds

- (a) a Certificate in Public Health Inspection (Canada) issued by the Board of Certification, or
- (b) a Certificate in Sanitary Inspection (Canada) issued by the Board of Certification.

**(2)** Nothing in subsection (1) prevents a regional health authority from employing any student who requires work experience in order to receive certification as a public health inspector by the Board of Certification.

**Repeal**

**3** The *Qualifications of Inspectors Regulation* (AR 244/85) is repealed.
