## APPENDIX

### Timber Dues

#### **Part 1. Weekly Prices, Exchanges Rates, Forest Resource Improvement Association of Alberta (FRIAA) Portion of General Rate of Timber Dues, and Exceptions to General Rates of Timber Dues in the *Timber Management Regulation***

##### **A. General rate of timber dues for coniferous timber that is used or will be used to make lumber, pulp, or roundwood timber products.**

1. For the purpose of Schedule 1, s. 2(1) of the *Timber Management Regulation*, the weekly price is the free-on-board (F.O.B.) mill price for 1000 board feet, Western S-P-F lumber that is kiln-dried, 2 inch by 4 inch, #2 and better as stated in the publication "*Random Lengths: The Weekly Report on North American Forest Product Markets*" published by Fastmarkets RISI Inc.
2. For the purpose of Schedule 1, s. 2(2)(a)(ii) of the *Timber Management Regulation*, the exchange rate to adjust a weekly price obtained from the publication referred to in clause A.1. above into Canadian dollars for a particular week is calculated by averaging the daily exchange rates established by the Bank of Canada in the online publication "*Daily Exchange Rates*" for all of the days within that week.
3. For the purposes of Schedule 1, s. 3(1) of the *Timber Management Regulation*, the portion of the general rate of timber dues that must be remitted to the Forest Resource Improvement Association of Alberta are found in Table 1 Column 2 in Part 2 under the heading "FRIAA Portion."

##### **B. General rate of timber dues for timber that is used or will be used to make oriented strand board.**

1. For the purpose of Schedule 2, s. 2(1) of the *Timber Management Regulation*, the weekly price is the F.O.B. mill price per 1000 square feet of 7/16 inch oriented strand board, Western Canada region, as stated in the publication "*Random Lengths Weekly Report: Panel Price Guide*" published by Fastmarkets RISI Inc.
2. For the purpose of Schedule 2, s. 2(3)(a)(ii) of the *Timber Management Regulation*, the exchange rate used to adjust a weekly price obtained from the publication referred to in clause B.1. into Canadian dollars for a particular week is calculated by averaging the daily exchange rates established by the Bank of Canada in the online publication "*Daily Exchange Rates*" for all of the days within that week.

**C. General rate of timber dues for deciduous timber that is used or will be used to make pulp.**

1. For the purpose of Schedule 3, s. 2(a)(i) of the *Timber Management Regulation*, the monthly price is the pulp price, or is the mid-point of the range if pulp prices are set out as a range of prices, per air dry metric tonne of Northern Boreal Hardwood Bleached Kraft, delivered to the United States, as stated in the publication "*PPI Pulp & Paper Week: Paper, Packaging, and Fibre Market News and Prices for North America*" published by Fastmarkets RISI Inc.
2. For the purpose of Schedule 3, s. 2(a)(ii) of the *Timber Management Regulation*, the exchange rate used to adjust a monthly price obtained from the publication referred to in clause B.1. into Canadian dollars for a particular month is calculated by averaging the daily exchange rates established by the Bank of Canada in the online publication "*Daily Exchange Rates*" for all of the days within that month.
3. For the purpose of Schedule 3, s. 3(1)(b) of the *Timber Management Regulation*, the annual price index is determined by reference to "Table 36-10-0130-01" of the "Provincial and Territorial Gross Domestic Product (GDP) by Income and Expenditure Accounts" program published by Statistics Canada.
4. For the purposes of Schedule 3, s. 4(1) of the *Timber Management Regulation*, the portion of the general rate of timber dues that must be remitted to the Forest Resource Improvement Association of Alberta are found in Table 3, Column 2 in Part 4 under the heading "FRIAA Portion."

**D. General rate of timber dues for timber that is used or will be used to make veneer.**

1. For the purpose of Schedule 4, s. 2(1) of the *Timber Management Regulation*:
  - a. the weekly price for veneer manufactured into plywood is the F.O.B. mill price per 1000 square feet of CD-graded 1/2 inch, 4-ply plywood sheathing, Western region, as stated in the publication "*Random Lengths Weekly Report: Panel Price Guide*" published by Fastmarkets RISI Inc.
  - b. the price for veneer manufactured into laminated veneer lumber is the average mill net selling price, F.O.B. mill, received by the producer in the payment month for its sales of laminated veneer lumber, green veneer and dry veneer. The producer shall calculate and report to the Department the average mill net selling price, in Canadian dollars, by:
    - i. determining the producer's total revenue for the payment month for laminated veneer lumber, green veneer and dry veneer, adjusted to bring the revenues to a F.O.B. basis by deducting any shipping costs beyond the mill yard, but not deducting any discounts for brokerage fees or early payments,
    - ii. converting any laminated veneer lumber sales in the payment month measured in cubic feet to thousands of square feet on a 3/8 inch basis

by multiplying the cubic feet volume by 0.032 and determining a total volume of laminated veneer lumber sales in thousands of square feet on a 3/8 inch basis for the payment month,

- iii. determining the volume of green and dry veneer sales in the payment month in thousands of square feet on a 3/8 inch basis,
  - iv. dividing the total mill net revenues determined in subclause (i) by the sum of the laminated veneer lumber sales volume determined in subclause (ii) and green and dry veneer sales volume determined in subclause (iii), and
  - v. where intra-corporate transfers or sales to affiliates, associates and subsidiaries exceed 10% of the total value of sales in the payment month, subtracting any intra-corporate transfers or sales to affiliates from the calculation of the average mill net selling price.
2. For the purpose of Schedule 4, s. 2(2)(a)(iii) of the *Timber Management Regulation*, the exchange rate used to adjust the weekly price obtained from the publication referred to in clause D.1.a. above into Canadian dollars for a particular week is calculated by averaging the daily exchange rate as established by the Bank of Canada in the online publication "*Daily Exchange Rates*" for all of the days within that week.

**Explanatory Notes:**

1. To determine the applicable general rate of timber dues based upon the lumber price for the month, users require a paid subscription to "Random Lengths: The Weekly Report on North American Forest Product Markets" published by Fastmarkets RISI Inc.
2. To determine the average monthly price, as per Schedule 1, s. 2(2)(a) of the *Timber Management Regulation*, users must adjust the weekly price from the last week ending in a Friday of the month preceding the payment month, and the prices from the three preceding weeks, into Canadian dollars, and average the 4 weekly converted prices. The pricing range in Column 1 that the monthly price falls within corresponds with the dues payable in the same row of Column 2.

3. For users who do not have subscriptions to the publications referred to above, the Department publishes dues letters setting out the general rates of timber dues for the period covered by the letter on the Alberta.ca website. Dues letters are published on a monthly-basis for Table 1.
4. Based upon the product price for a month, the Total Dues (Column 2) in the same row as the applicable product price (Column 1) is the effective general rate of timber dues.

To determine the average quarterly price, as per Schedule 2, s. 2(3)(a) of the *Timber Management Regulation*, users must adjust the weekly price from all weeks ending in a Friday in the quarter into Canadian dollars, and average the weekly prices. The pricing range in Column 1 that the quarterly price falls within corresponds with the dues payable in the same row of Column 2.
3. For users who do not have a subscription to the publication referred to above, the Department publishes dues letters setting out the general rates of timber dues for the period covered by the letter on the Alberta.ca website. Dues letters are published on a quarterly basis for Table 2.
4. Based upon the product price for a quarter, the Total Dues (Column 2) in the same row as the applicable product price (Column 1) is the effective general rate of timber dues.
